

Bottle type	Description
Angled neck bottle	Bottle with an angled neck section, usually used for toilet cleaner.
Anti-bac bottle	Usually a flat rectangular bottle, often used for hand soap.
Boston bottle	Round or oval bottle with a radiused shoulder.
Cylindrical bottle	Bottle with a round section, usually sloping shoulders.
Flask	Term sometimes used for a spray bottle.
Jerry can or jerrican	Bulk bottle with a handle, 1000ml to 30 litres.
Plascan	Old term usually referring to rectangular bottle.
Poly bottle	Term sometimes used for cylindrical bottles.
Swipe	As above.
Swirl	Term sometime used for waisted bottles.
Tubular bottle	Bottle with a round base and flat shoulders.
UN jerry can	Stacking jerry can certified by the UN as suitable for transporting liquid products by air or surface freight, should display the UN certification reference.
Waisted bottle	Cylindrical bottle with a narrow section to give a good grip.
